PASTORELA

MEADOW FESCUE

Festuca pratensis Huds.

ORIGIN

Pastorela was gained via crossing the meadow fescue variety Kolumbus (registered in Germany) with varieties from around the world. Pastorela is registered in the Czech Republic.

DISTINCTIONS OF THE VARIETY

- good digestibility higher content of proteins
- high yield potential greater density and higher seed yield
- good disease resistance

DESCRIPTION

Pastorela is not as late as Kolumbus but is later than the majority of varieties around the world. The height of the plants at heading time is greater in comparision to Kolumbus.

Pastorela is a five-cut meadow fescue. The variety is characterised by its even yields throughout the five cuts in the course of the production year.

Pastorela has a better resistance to rust and to leaf spot. Pastorela shows higher digestibility. The variety has a lower content of fibre and other characteristics are higher crude protein content and higher metabolised energy.

Pastorela is intended for pasture and meadow mixtures and for red clover grass mixtures.

- in mixtures for long term pastures and meadows
- in mixtures with clovers for short term meadows
